■ To do this you have to write an academic text

- Different parts of a manuscript are involved:
- Title
- Abstract with key words
- Introduction
- Materials and methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- Acknowledgment
- References



Should support aim of your study

You have to involved critical points of your study in the title



 Background, material and method, results and conclusion

■ 250 words



You should select words that support your study

• A to Z

Introduction

You should write introduction in 3 or 4 paragraph

It is best that you mention all aspects of your study in the introduction

Proper references must be putted in this section



- Is sectional
- You must put reference for any method
- You must involved design of your study to m&m

 At the end of m&m you have to explain statistical analysis

results

- □ Is sectional, commonly
- Must report significant differences only

- Table and figures

discussion

- Start by your findings
- Resemble to introduction
- But compare your results with findings of other researches

conclusion

In a small paragraph you must mention top findings

- Fund
- support
